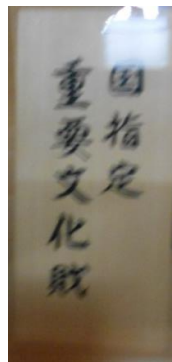




Hello, everyone. I'll explain Jizo.



It's a wooden standing statue of "Jizo Bosatsu".

It's at Jozan-ji Temple in Koshigaya.

It was designated as a National Important Cultural Property
in March 2016.

It was made about in the ninth century, the early Heian period.

It's the second oldest in Japan.

It's 92.5 centimeters tall.

The Statue "Jizo-Bosatsu" is open to the public on February 24
and August 24 every year at Jozan-ji Temple.
