Hello, everyone. I'll explain the stone monument.





・旧忍藩領の石碑 ・越谷市大成町2-331

This stone monument is in Taiseicyo, Koshigaya.

It was built in about 1700. And it's 2 meters high.

The area around Taiseicho was an enclave of the Oshi domain during the Edo period. *忍藩(現在の行田市)

The Oshi domain is the current city of Gyoda in Saitama prefecture.

On the inscription is engraved that the east from here is the territory of the Oshi domain. *従是(これより)東忍領

So this stone monument represents the territory of the Oshi domain.

Gyoda is about one hour by train from Koshigaya.
